

Based on responses we've received we are listing some specific ways you can help as well as providing some corrections to statements being made.

Listed below are ways you can help:

- 1. Provide Legal and Insurance/Risk Assistance: If you, or someone you know, can provide legal or risk mitigation assistance, please reach out to the EWA Board. We need help fully understanding the legal implications of the Agreement and mitigation solutions.**
- 2. Reach out to the County:** Voice your support for EWA in our request for the County to take a more reasonable approach to the smaller organization and allow them to continue without the overreach imposed by the new agreement. EWA is not a club, travel, or for-profit business. EWA provides support to WCPR youth recreational programs as a service to the local community. Some from the community have asked for a specific message to send to the County. Here is an example:

Dear Mayor, Director, and County Attorney,

I hope you are all doing well. I'm writing as a member of the community to voice my support for our local youth sports organization and specifically EWA. This program has been an important part of our county for many years, and it plays a major role in helping our kids learn, grow, and stay active.

I'm concerned about the new agreement being proposed. From what I understand, it places a heavy burden on the volunteers who run these programs. I respectfully ask that the county work toward a more reasonable and balanced approach—one that protects the county's interests while also supporting the volunteers who make these activities possible and the participants and families who take part.

Our youth programs truly benefit the community, and I hope the county will partner with them in a fair and supportive way.
